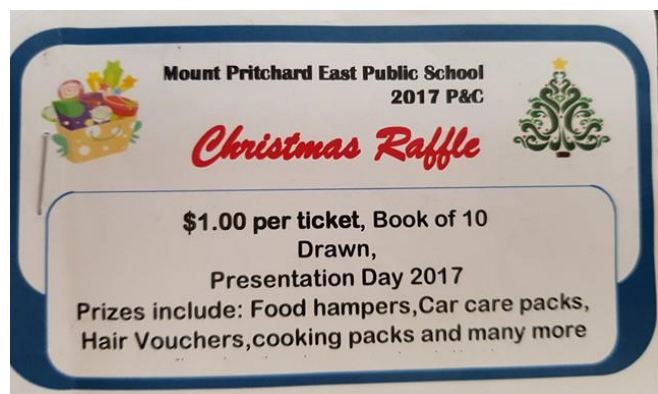
Congratulations to 1C for having the Most Items in their Donation Hamper. Thank you SD for all your donations.
