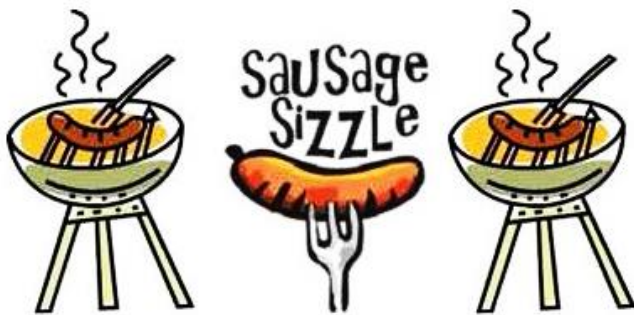
**P&C Meeting:** Term 4 Week 3 Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October.
